Do I qualify for Care Management?

You need to receive Medicaid, and additionally you must meet only one of the following conditions:

- Living with HIV/AIDS or
- A Significant Mental Illness or
- Two or more chronic health conditions, such as asthma, diabetes, heart disease, mental health condition or substance use disorder

You also must have any one or more of what are considered risk factors, which can include homelessness or risk of homelessness, lack of family support, and others; contact us for details.
