Do we qualify for Children's Care Management?

Villa of Hope serves families that have children from ages 5 to 21 that are enrolled in Medicaid and have one or more of the following:

- A qualifying mental health diagnosis
- At least two chronic health conditions
- HIV or AIDS
- Have experienced chronic trauma that is affecting their daily life functioning
