JUVENILE REPORTING CENTER

JRC is the only 5 day per week after-school program locally for youth ages 13½ to 21, referred to our program by Monroe County Probation or FACT. We work alongside Probation Officers and the Department of Human Services to provide:

- Monthly home visits
- Case management, provider collaboration and parenting assistance
- Referrals for mental health, chemical dependency and health homes
