

This 18-bed medically supervised withdrawal and treatment center on the beautiful Villa of Hope Dewey Avenue campus is underway! This facility will be the only one of its kind in Monroe County to treat adolescents, as well as adults.

This Behavioral Health Clinic will provide vital mental health and substance use disorder and recovery services to our campus youth, and will open up treatment options to our entire community. We will serve ages 5 through adult; we will save lives here.

FAQ Frequently asked questions



1. When do these facilities open?

Our Living Hope Detox Center will open first, followed by the Integrated Behavioral Health Clinic; and grand openings are anticipated to begin in early Fall, 2021.

2. Why does this matter for New York State?

In 2017, 32% percent of county residents (1,700 people) seeking detox services had to travel outside of Monroe County, and often even to Pennsylvania, due to a lack of bed availability. The Villa's new facility will give a local option to serve a desperate need.

With opioid use at an all-time high and the increasing numbers of overdoses and deaths due to substance abuse, Villa of Hope is proud to provide groundbreaking and life-changing opportunities for adolescents and adults to find hope and to recover and rebuild their lives through specialized detox programs.

3. Are either of these facilities the first of their kind in our area?

Our Living Hope Detox Center, a medically supervised withdrawal and stabilization treatment home, is the first community, agency-run inpatient center of its kind in Monroe County. The Center will be the only facility in our area to serve adolescents, beginning at age 16.

4. What are the ages served for the Behavioral Health Clinic?

Our Behavior Health Clinic provides outpatient mental health and substance use disorder treatment services for ages 5 through adult.

5. What are the ages served for the Living Hope Detox Center?

Our Detox Center will serve ages 16 through adult.

6. How does this impact Villa of Hope?

The addition of these two facilities rounds out the Villa's continuum of care. After completing withdrawal at our Living Hope Detox Center, patients will be able to continue treatment in other programs such as the Villa of Hope Outpatient Clinic, and with Care Coordination services. They can also take advantage of adolescent residential programs, or Workforce Development programs. Practitioners will be able, literally, to walk patients from one building to the next for continued help.
